

The Three Little Pigs

Home Learning Challenge



Tell a grown-up the story of The Three Little Pigs. Remember to use different voices for the characters. You could even act it out together!



Perhaps the pigs would like to send a picture of their brick house to their mummy pig. Can you draw a picture of the house for them? What will you need to include?

Build a chimney with boxes or make one with paper or card. Can you use your fingers to show the wolf climbing down the chimney and then show him jumping out of the pot and running away?



How many little pigs were there? Can you show 3 on your fingers? Can you make some other groups of 3 with things you can find at home? You might find 3 toys, 3 spoons or 3 books.



Think of some words that start with the same sound as 'pig'. How many can you come up with?
