## Home Learning Challenge

Explain how the pigs in the story are different to real pigs. Are there any ways in which they are the same?



Build a model of a house that would stay standing when the wolf huffed and puffed. You could try blowing it with a fan to test it out.

Write down 5 words that rhyme with pig.



Can you draw a map to show the home where the pigs grew up, the road they went along and the three houses they built? Can you add some trees and mountains?

Make a pig or a wolf mask by drawing a face and cutting it out.



The third little pig bought 10 bricks but only used 8 of them. How many were left? Can you use your fingers or make marks on paper to help you work this out?

The little pigs lived happily together in the brick house. What jobs did they need to do to look after their house? Are there jobs you could help with in your house?
